A. GRAMMAR

1. Adverbs of manner (Trạng từ chỉ cách thức)

- Chức năng: bổ nghĩa cho động từ.
- Diễn tả một hành động xảy ra hoặc được thực hiện như thế nào.
- Vị trí: trạng từ (Adv) thường đứng sau động từ (Verb).

VD: He writes quickly.

V Adv

- Cấu tạo Trạng từ chỉ cách thức: thường **thêm đuôi -ly sau tính từ**.

(Với tính từ kết thúc bằng -y: chuyển -y thành -i rồi thêm -ly. VD: happy ⇒ happily)

Có quy tắc: strong – strongly bad – badly sad – sadly
crazy – crazily lucky – luckily angry – angrily

Bất quy tắc: good – well fast – fast late – late

2. Past simple (Quá khứ đơn)

- Thì quá khứ đơn dùng để diễn tả hành động đã xảy ra và chấm dứt hoàn toàn trong quá khứ.

- **Past simple of regular verb (Quá khứ với động từ có quy tắc)**

Ở thì quá khứ đơn, một số động từ thường được chia bằng cách thêm đuôi **-ed** vào phía sau.

Example: walk - walked play – played remember – remembered
celebrate - celebrated listen – listened study - studied

- **Past simple of irregular verbs (Quá khứ với động từ bất quy tắc)**

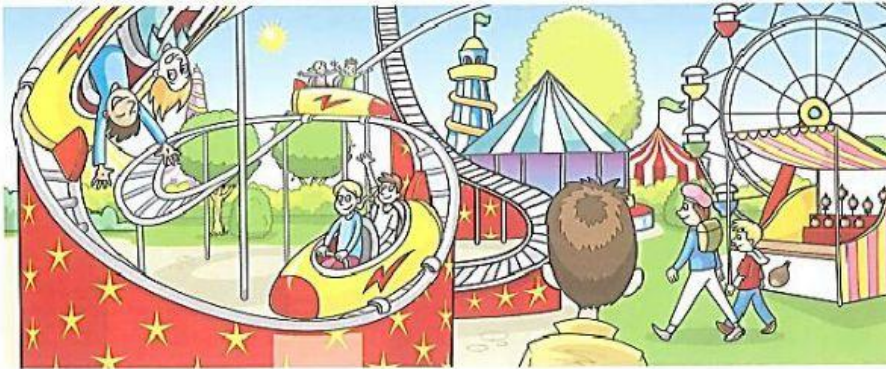

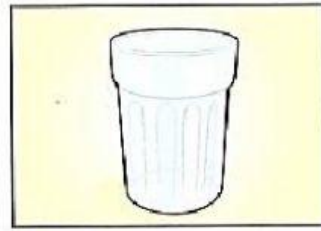

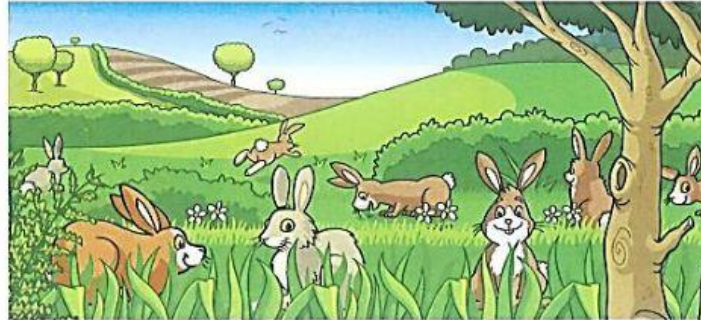
