

## Change "if" to "unless"

Example:

If she doesn't come soon, I'm going to call her.

Unless she comes soon, I'm going to call her.

1. If it doesn't rain, we'll leave early in the morning.
2. If we don't catch the bus, we'll walk to the next stop.
3. If we aren't careful, we'll fall down the stairs.
4. If your hat isn't tied well, it will be blown away.
5. If we don't study, we won't pass the exam.
6. If you don't use the sailboat, we'll use it.
7. If she doesn't miss the train, she'll get there by this afternoon.
8. If Bill isn't at home, I don't know where he is.
9. If the museum isn't closed, we'll stay until 2.

### Change Unless to if

Fred said he'd go unless it snowed.

Fred said he'd go if it didn't snow.

1. I'll eat this fish unless you want it.
2. Unless you get there early, you'll have to stand up.
3. They'll lose the game unless they practice a lot.
4. I can't go the university unless I make good grades.
5. You'll see me at the library unless you see me at the laboratory.
6. We'll have to leave the classroom unless we stop talking.
7. Unless they obey the rules, they'll get in trouble.
8. Unless you go to her party, she won't come to yours.
9. I won't go swimming unless the water is warm.
10. The fruit tree won't grow unless you water it frequently.
