Notice: Analyze the following table of the use of the following grammar structures for future.

Going to	Will
We use "going to" to talk about definite future plans or intentions.	Use "will" to talk about possible future plans, especially after certain expressions - probably, maybe, think.
<b>Affirmative</b> Subject + am/is/are + going to + verb + object  I <b>am going to</b> travel to Cancun  You We <b>are going to</b> travel to Cancun They  She <b>is going to</b> travel to Cancun He	<b>Affirmative</b> Subject + will + verb + object think..... / Maybe.... /  Probably... I think, I <b>will</b> travel to Cancun  Maybe, You We They will travel to Cancun  Probably, She <b>will</b> travel to Cancun He
<b>Negative</b> Subject + am/is/are + not + going to + verb + object  I <b>am not going to</b> travel to Cancun  You We <b>aren't going to</b> travel to Cancun They  She <b>isn't going to</b> travel to Cancun He	<b>Negative</b> Subject + won't + verb + object think..... / Maybe.... / Probably...  I think, I <b>won't</b> travel to Cancun  Maybe, You We <b>won't</b> travel to Cancun They  Probably, She <b>won't</b> travel to He Cancun

<p><b>Question</b> am/is/are + subject + going to + verb + object</p> <p><b>Am I going to</b> Cancun?</p> <p><b>Are</b> <sup>you</sup><del>we</del><b>going to</b> travel to Cancun? <sup>they</sup></p> <p><b>Is</b> <sup>she</sup><del>he</del> going to travel to Cancun? <sup>he</sup></p>	<p><b>Question</b> Will + subject + verb + object</p> <p><b>Will I travel to</b> Cancun?</p> <p><sup>you</sup> <b>Will</b><del>we</del> travel to Cancun? <sup>they</sup></p> <p><b>Will</b> <sup>she</sup><del>he</del> travel to Cancun? <sup>he</sup></p>
