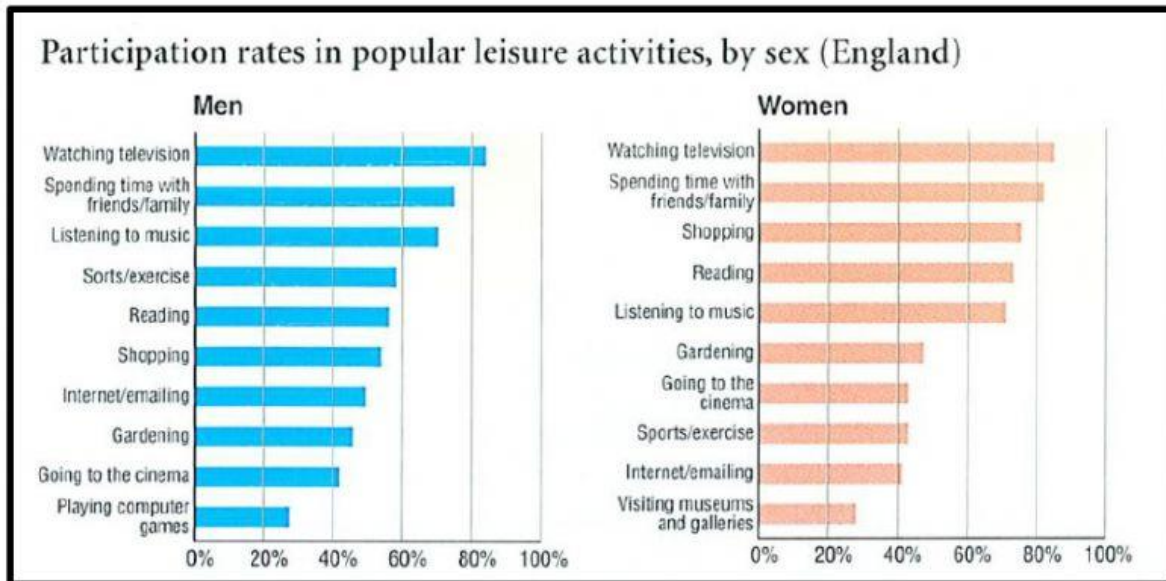


WRITING Task 1: Presenting and Comparing Data

Spending time with friends and family is the 5 most common leisure activity for both men 6 and women (82%).

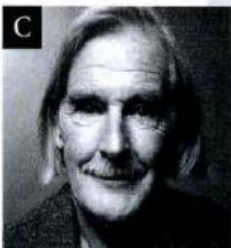
However, there are also some differences between the 7 Men are more likely than women to 8 sport and exercise (58% compared with 43%) while women are more likely to spend their free time 9 , with three quarters doing so, compared with around 10 of men. Similarly, women were more likely to engage in cultural activities 11 reading (73%), compared with men (56%).

12 , it seems there is general consistency between the sexes in their choice of leisure activities, despite some differences in individual rankings.
