Have something done / have + sth + 3^{rd}

How to solve a rewriting activity:

Example: His teeth are checked twice a year.

Ask questions:

Whose eyes?? Who is the person receiving the service or favour?? HE

What is the thing that receives the service?? HIS TEETH

What is the service itself?? What is the verb that mentions the action?? ARE CHECKED

How often?? When?? Which tense do you need?? TWICE A YEAR --- PRESENT SIMPLE

Example: His teeth are checked twice a year.

HE	HAS	HIS TEETH	CHECKED	TWICE A YEAR.
WHO RECEIVES THE SERVICE?	PRESENT SIMPLE	THE THING/ SOMETHING	THE SERVICE/ THE ACTION	WHEN? GIVES ME THE TENSE
