- Question form: **do, does** + subject + infinitive.
- There is no **s** at the end of the verb in questions:
She lives ... but Does she live ...?
NOT ~~Does she lives ...?~~

Add **do** or **does** to make questions and **do**, **don't**, **does** or **doesn't** to make short answers.
