- Do/does->questions
- Don't/doesn't->negative sentences
- 3rd person

ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY

-Adverbs: always, often, sometimes, usually, hardly ever, never...

-I am usually ill  After verb to be

-I usually study  Before verb rest of the verbs

-I never get ill  Always + verb
