	PARTS OF THE FLOWER	FUNCTIONS
		It connects the stigma to the ovary.
		They produce and release pollen grains.
		They protect the bud (baby flower). They are green.
		They protect the stigma and style. They attract insects because they have beautiful colours and a pleasant smell.
		It supports the anther.
		It is the top of the pistil. It is sticky so it can trap the pollen grains.
		It produces and contains ovules. Ovules turn into seeds after fertilization.
