

POSSESSIVE NOUNS

shows that a person or thing owns or has something

SINGULAR POSSESSIVE NOUNS

to make a singular possessive noun, add 's

Example:

The cat's tail is gray.

PLURAL POSSESSIVE NOUNS

if the plural noun ends in -s, add an ' to the end of the word

Example:

The boys' bags were accidentally left outside.

if the plural noun is a different word, add 's

Example:

The children's toys were quickly put away.

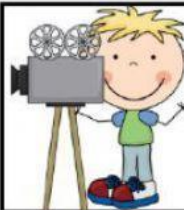
