AFFIRMATIVE (+)

### PRONOUN + VERB INFINITIVE

(I, you, we, they)

- They like to watch Stranger Things.
- I ride my bike to go to university.

NEGATIVE (-)

### PRONOUN + DON'T + VERB INFINITIVE

(I, you, we, they)

- You don't live near your job, right?
- We don't share the same football team.

- at lunchtime
- at dinnertime
