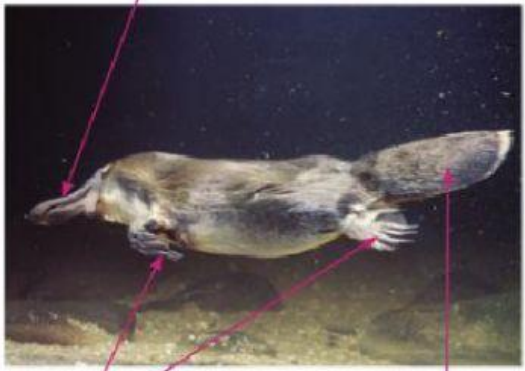
The tarsier
