ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY

1. When do we use them?

We use them to indicate how frequently we do an activity.

2. What words do we use?

100%	90-80%	70%	50%	30-20%	15-10%	0%
always	usually	often	sometimes	rarely	hardly ever	never

*Note: We always use the frequency adverb **BEFORE** the verb except with BE.*

ADVERB	EXAMPLE
always	✓ I always brush my teeth.
usually	✓ She usually cleans her room.
often	✓ We often travel together.
sometimes	✓ I sometimes wake up late.
rarely	✓ Max rarely goes to the zoo.
hardly ever	✓ They hardly ever call me.
never	✓ Tim never watches TV at night.

3. What question do they answer?

They answer the question **HOW OFTEN** (¿con qué frecuencia?)

4. How do we form the question?

WH-	AUX	SUBJECT	VERB BASE FORM	COMPLEMENT
How often	do	you	take	a shower?
	does	Randy	do	the dishes?

C. Exercise: Answer the questions about you using the frequency adverbs.

- How often do you wash the dishes?
 - I always wash the dishes.
- How often do you do the grocery shopping?
 - I often do the grocery shopping.
- How often do you make your bed?
 - I always make my bed.
- How often do you vacuum?
 - I sometimes vacuum.
- How often do you clean the bathroom?
 - I usually clean the bathroom.
- How often do you cook?
 - I always cook.
- How often do you take out the garbage?
 - I always take out the garbage.
- How often do you walk your dog?
 - I always walk my dog.
- How often do you do your laundry?
 - I usually do your laundry.
- How often do you mop the floor?
 - I usually mop the floor.
