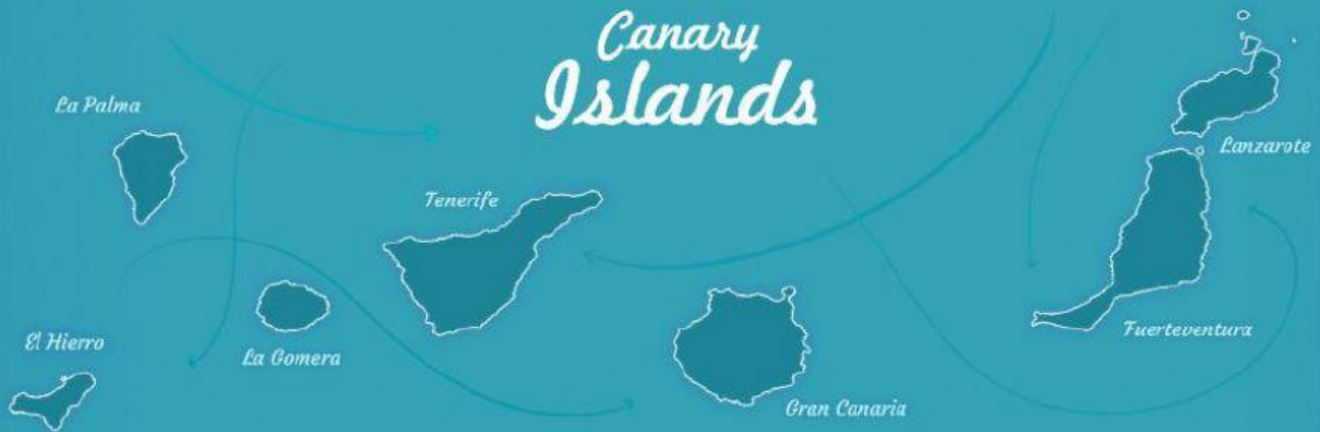


Canary Islands
