

PASSIVE VOICE - present simple

am / is / are + past participle

Active: Tom plays soccer

Passive: Soccer is played by Tom

- The object of the active becomes the new Subject in the passive.
- The passive verb changes into its passive form (past participle- 3. Form)
- The subject of the active becomes the by_agent in the passive.

Step by step

1. Define the tense? → simple present
2. Find the passive Object → soccer
3. Form of "to be" for the passive → soccer "is"
4. 3rd form of the verb → play = played
5. Passive sentence word order →
6. ~by_agent~ if needed → by Tom

Now you can build the sentence in passive voice.

Identifying Passive Voice

Use the following *indicators* to recognize passive voice

☛ It is unclear who or what is responsible for the action:

- Her car was broken into. (by whom?)

☛ The object of the action is in the subject slot of the sentence:

- Her Car was broken into by the shady neighbour.

☛ A sentence combines a form of "to be" (e.g. is, was, are...) with a past or future tense verb:

- Her window **was shattered** during the break-in.
- Her window **will be fixed** by a repairman.
