

# RELATIVE CLAUSES

Relative clauses give us information about the person/thing/place.  
**(EG. Where, Who, Which)**

We use Who to talk about people

EG: She's the woman who cuts my hair.  
He's the man who I met at the supermarket.



We use Where to talk about places.

EG: The bar where I met my wife is still there  
That is the place where I ate borscht.

We use Which to talk about things/animals.

EG: There is an elephant which loves to draw.  
The laptop which I bought is broken.

**Special Rule!!!**

We can use Which to compare two or more things/people/places.

EG: Which are the countries you would like to visit?  
These are the teachers which you can choose to learn from.
