

## Perception verbs: Bare Infinitive or Gerund?

**Verbs of perception:** see, hear, smell, feel, watch, look at, listen to, notice, observe ...

### The Rule:

Τα παραπάνω ρήματα αντιληφτικής μπορούν να συνταχθούν τόσο με gerund όσο και με bare infinitive, με μικρή διαφοροποίηση στο νόημα:

**Gerund:** Για πράξεις που βρίσκονται σε εξέλιξη όσο τις βλέπουμε (see), ακούμε (hear), παρατηρούμε (observe) κλπ. Η χρήση gerund υποδηλώνει πως η πράξη βρισκόταν ήδη σε εξέλιξη όταν εμείς την αντιληφθήκαμε και συχνά δίνει έμφαση στη διάρκεια της.

e.g. I **saw** Mary **greeting** Professor Grey. (The greeting was already in progress when I saw it)

**Bare infinitive:** Για για πράξεις που ξεκινούν και ολοκληρώνονται όσο τις βλέπουμε (see), ακούμε (hear), παρατηρούμε (observe) κλπ. Η χρήση bare infinitive υποδηλώνει πως η πράξη έγινε αντιληπτή από την αρχή ώς το τέλος της. Χρησιμοποιείται και για πράξεις στιγμιαίες.

e.g. I **saw** Mary **greet** Professor Grey. (I saw the whole greeting from the beginning to the end)

**Extra Tip:** To gerund δίνει τη σημασία του **while** (ενώ).

e.g. I **heard** my brother **singing** in the bathroom. (I heard my brother while he was singing)

I **heard** my brother **sing** in the bathroom. (I heard his singing from the beginning to the end)

**Be careful:** Όταν υπάρχει **can** ή **could** πριν από τα ρήματα αντιληφτικής το ρήμα που ακολουθεί μπαίνει πάντα σε gerund.

e.g. I **can hear** the waves **breaking**. I **could see** people **partying**.

### → Let's give it a go...

- When I arrived at the party I saw David \_\_\_\_\_ with Sophie. [DANCE]
- I saw David \_\_\_\_\_ with Sophie and felt really jealous. [DANCE]
- Can you see David \_\_\_\_\_ with Sophie? They look really happy! [DANCE]
- Are you deaf? Can't you hear the phone \_\_\_\_\_? [RING]
- The minute I heard the phone \_\_\_\_\_ I jumped off my chair to answer it. [RING]
- When I got home I heard the phone \_\_\_\_\_. [RING]
- I felt the bomb \_\_\_\_\_ and screamed really loud! [EXPLODE]
- Even from such a long distance you could feel the bomb \_\_\_\_\_. [EXPLODE]
- I walked into the room and noticed Mr. Evans \_\_\_\_\_. very strangely. [BEHAVE]
- When the party was almost over I noticed Mr. Evans \_\_\_\_\_. very strangely. [BEHAVE]
- I watched his plane \_\_\_\_\_, unable to hold my tears. [TAKE OFF]
- When I arrived at the terminal I saw his plane \_\_\_\_\_. [TAKE OFF]
- I love this spot! From here you can see many planes \_\_\_\_\_. [TAKE OFF]
- I love listening to the birds \_\_\_\_\_ when I wake up. [SING]
- Be quiet! I can't listen to the birds \_\_\_\_\_. [SING]
