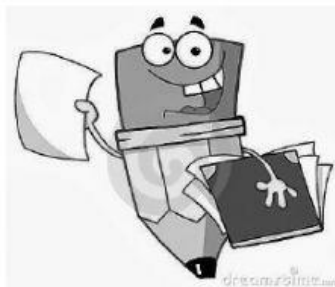


DESCRIPTIVE ADJECTIVES

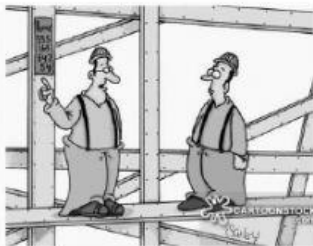
