COMPARING MONSTERS



We add **-er** or **-ier** to an adjective to make comparisons:

Tall -> Taller Short -> Shorter Big -> Bigger Small -> Smaller
Pretty -> Prettier Ugly -> Uglier Smart -> Smarter Silly -> Sillier
Scary -> Scarier Friendly -> Friendlier
Good -> Better Bad -> Worse

1. Mike is **shorter/taller** Sully.
2. Randall is **better/scarier** than Mike.
3. Celia is **uglier/prettier** than Roz.
4. Smitty and Needleman are **smarter/sillier** than Roz.
5. Fungus is **smaller/bigger** than Mr. Waternoose.
6. Randall is **worse/better** than Sully.
7. Mike is **angrier/happier** than Roz.
8. Needleman is **taller/shorter** than Smitty.
9. Mr. Waternoose is **uglier/prettier** than Celia.
10. Smitty and Needleman are **funnier/smarter** than Roz.
