When writing a review of a TV programme, we use a variety of adjectives and adverbs to improve the quality of our writing. It's important to use the correct **word order**. **Adjectives** usually come before a noun or after the verb *to be*. **Adverbs of manner** come after the verb. **Adverbs of degree** come before an adverb of manner or an adjective.

The participants are **really ridiculous**.

The TV host dances **very strangely** and sings **loudly**.
