

Idioms to express satisfaction/dissatisfaction

Idioms for satisfaction =)

To be a happy camper

Meaning: a happy or satisfied person

Example: John is a happy camper after hearing about his promotion.

To jump for joy

Meaning: to be ecstatically happy

Example: Alba is jumping for joy because the director loves her business idea.

Idioms for dissatisfaction =(

To have the blues

Meaning: to be feeling sad or depressed

Example: Chris really has the blues because things with his girlfriend are not fine.

To be bummed out

Meaning: Feeling depressed or sad about an issue

Example: The team is really bummed out because the client doesn't like the new design.
