
Facilities

Even though Chek Jawa has a very natural environment, a few facilities have been built to enhance your experience there. Do check out these facilities when you visit Chek Jawa!

Jejawi Tower
Climb this 20-metre (7-storey) tall tower to get a bird's-eye view of Chek Jawa, as well as some exotic birds.



Visitor Centre
This was converted from a house built in the 1930s. Start your visit here!



Boardwalk
This 1-kilometre long walkway has been built to bring you closer to nature. Try the Mangrove Loop and the Coastal Loop!

Viewing Jetty
This is the best place to look out to sea. See if you can spot any interesting marine life from here!

Getting There

Here's how you can get to Chek Jawa by public transport:

Take an MRT train to Tanah Merah MRT station (EW4) on the East-West line.

Take bus number 2 to Changi Village bus terminal

Take a short 3-minute walk to Changi Point ferry terminal.

Walk along tarmac roads and dirt trails. It should take about 1.5–2 hours.

Alight at the Ubin jetty. There are 3 ways to get to Chek Jawa which is about 3 kilometres away.

Take a bumboat to Pulau Ubin. Be careful not to board the one to Johor!

Chek Jawa

Take a taxi van. Like the bumboats, they leave once there are 12 passengers.

Rent a bicycle from one of the bicycle rental shops at the jetty, cycle to Punai Hut, park your bicycle there, then walk to Chek Jawa.






