


# This\that\these\those

- 1 Use *this/these* for things near you (*here*).
- 2 Use *that/those* for things which aren't near you (*there*).
- *this/that* = singular; *these/those* = plural.
- *this, that, these, and those* can be adjectives (*this watch*) or pronouns (*What's *this*?*).



What's **this**? It's a ticket.  
**These** watches are Japanese.  
**That** car is Italian.  
What are **those**? They're headphones.


