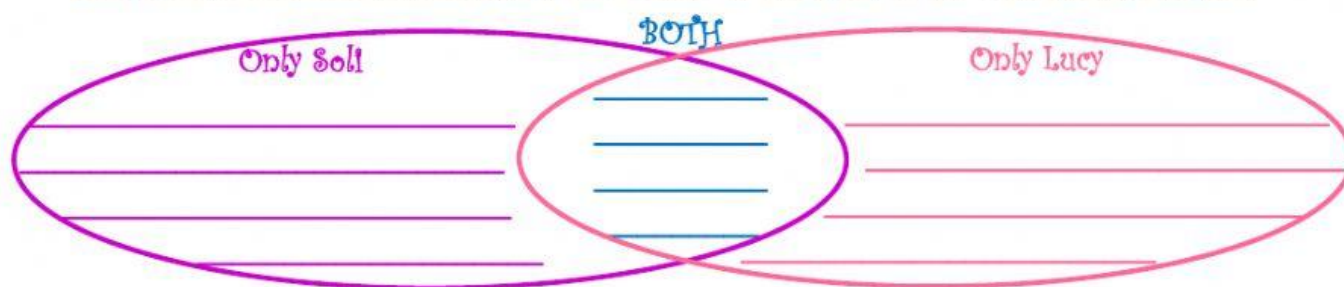


**compare** = tell how 2 things are the **same**

**contrast** = tell how 2 things are **different**

Compare and contrast Soli and Lucy. Put 4 ideas in each part of the Venn (circle) diagram.



**similar** = the **same** in some ways, but not *all* ways
