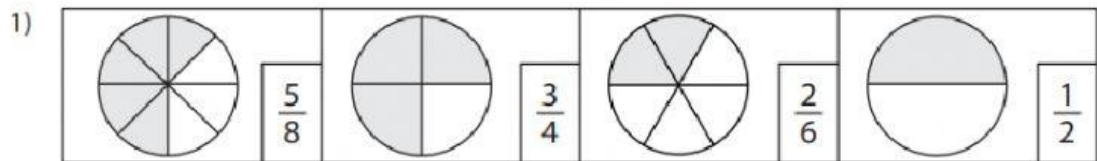
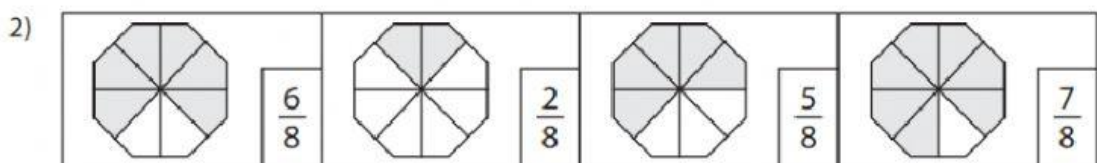

Ordering Fractions

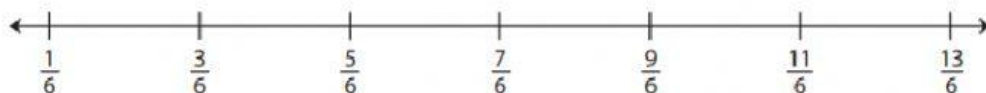
1. | Order the fractions from smallest to largest.



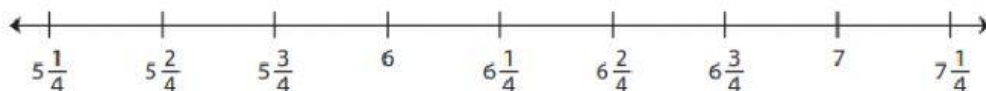


2. Plot the fractions on the number line, and write them in increasing order.
