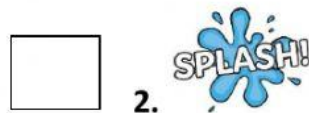
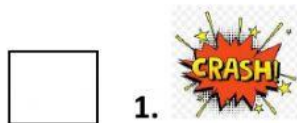


ONOMATOPOEIA refers to words that imitate the sounds associated with the objects or actions they refer to.
