

immediate family	made up of the same kind of people or things
interdependence	your parents, brothers, sisters, and children
translate	someone with a higher position at work
freely	changing
superior (n)	the state of people needing one another
criticism	comments that note the problems with something
homogeneous	to move or apply something to a new place or situation
fluid	easily or openly

inequality	a system of organization in which people are divided into levels of importance
hierarchy	a situation in which some groups in society have less money, influence, or opportunity than others
concentrated	containing a lot of something compared to other places or situations
egalitarian	behaving in a confident way
dynamics	a range or series of related things, in which each thing is only slightly different from the one before or after, so that there are no clear dividing points
assertive	the ways in which things or people behave, react, and affect each other
continuum	believing that everyone is equal and should have equal rights

orientation	the ability to give up an immediate reward in order to wait for a later one
in the long run	wise and careful use of money so that none is wasted
bottom line	the profits made by a business in a certain period
delayed gratification	the goals, interests, and emphasis of a company, political group, etc.
persistence	over a long period of time
thrift	the determination to do something even though it is difficult or other people oppose it
