

PAST SIMPLE. NEGATIVE!

We sometimes need to use the past simple in negative. It is very easy. You have to use this:

SUBJECT+ DIDN'T + VERB IN INFINITIVE.

Example.

I played basketball yesterday.

I didn't play basketball yesterday.

She cooked pasta yesterday

She didn't cook pasta yesterday

No -ed at the end in negative.

INCORRECT.

- I didn't played
