$9 \times 13 = ?$ Consider this as $10 \times 13 = 130$ Now remove 13 from this. $130 - 13 = 117$ Note: It is easier to round the number to 10 here and multiply that with 13 . Now your problem becomes easier to solve.	$11 \times 12 = ?$ Consider this as $10 \times 12 = 120$ Now add 12 to this. $120 + 12 = 132$ Note: It is easier to round the number to 10 here and multiply that with 12 . Now your problem becomes easier to solve.
