Life on the International Space Station



Some people dream of traveling into space. However, life in space is not very easy. Here are some of the problems that people on the International Space Station (ISS) have.

- 1 Having lunch on the ISS is very difficult because there is no **gravity** in space, and things never **stay** where you put them. Food comes in plastic containers because the food can't stay on a **plate**.
- 2 When they go outside, people wear special **clothes**, because there is no **atmosphere** in space. It is also very cold in space. Inside the ISS, people can wear **ordinary** clothes.
- 3 You can't take a shower in space because the water doesn't stay in one place. People wash with a **sponge** with water and soap.
- 4 People on the ISS can't sleep in normal beds because their bodies don't stay in the beds. They use special **sleeping bags** on the wall.
