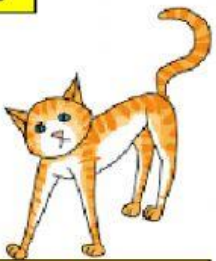

IMPORTANT!

Opposite significa "opuesto"

LAZY: When you don't want to do anything and you like sleeping.

OLD: A person who is 90 years old is an old person.

TALL: Someone who isn't short. If your height is 2 meters you are tall. Giraffes are tall.

FAT: A cat that eats a lot of food and has a big belly is fat.

FUNNY: Something funny makes you laugh. A clown is funny.

YOUNG: Young is the opposite of old. For example, if you are 6 years old, you are young.

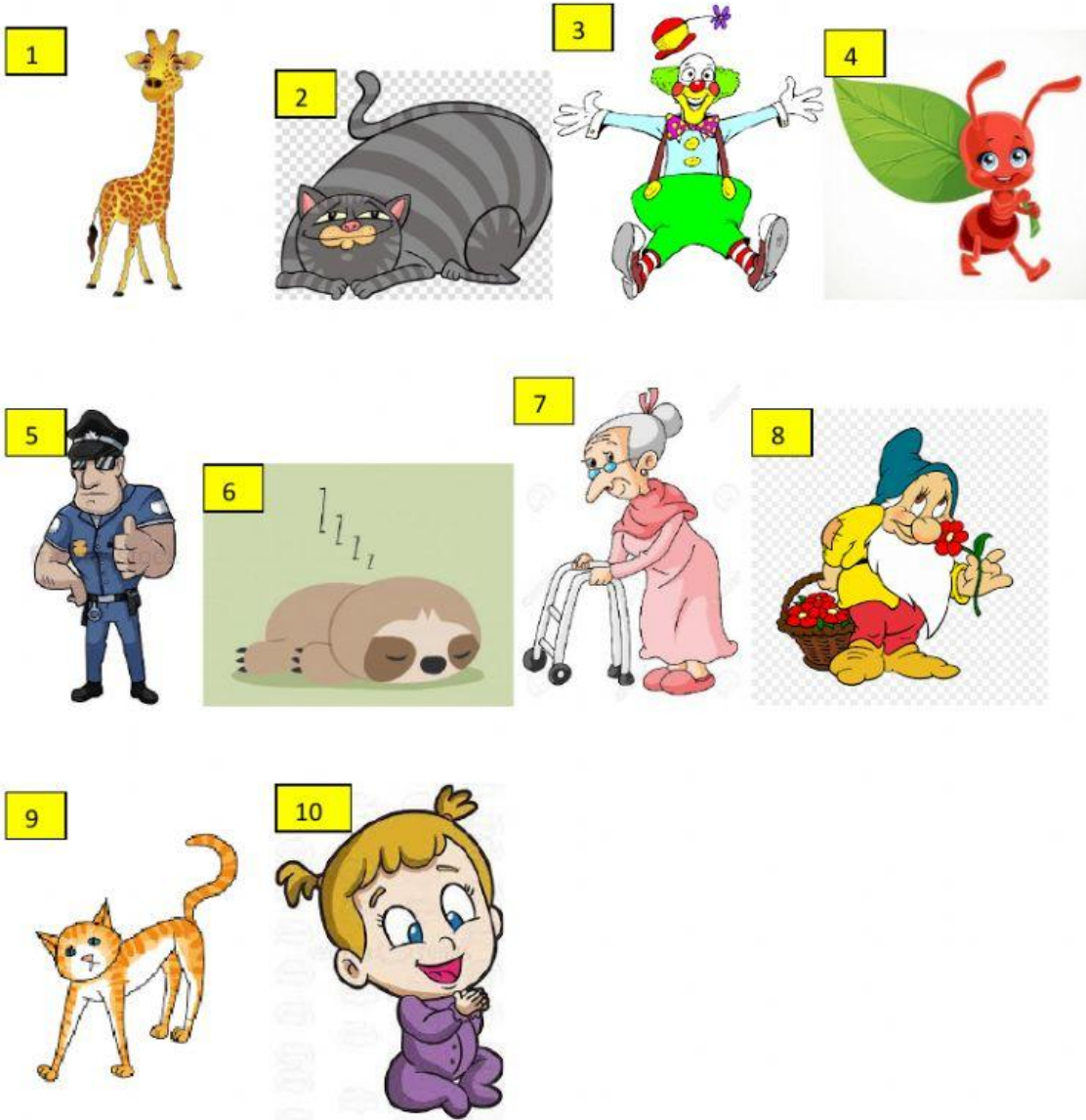
THIN: Thin is the opposite of fat. For example, a cat who doesn't eat a lot of food is thin.

HARD-WORKING: Hard-working is the opposite of lazy. When you work a lot you're hard-working.

SHORT: Short is the opposite of tall. For example, Blancanieves' dwarfs are short.

SERIOUS: It is the opposite of funny. You are serious when you can't laugh because you're doing something important. Policemen are serious.

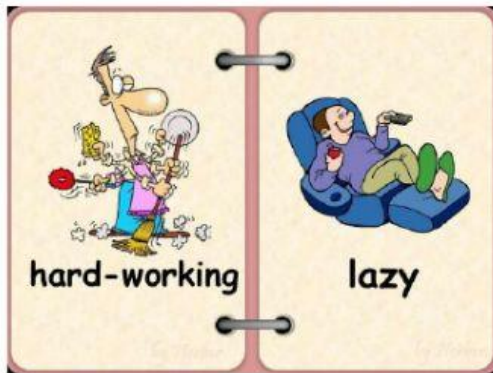

For example:

FAT + ER + THAN → FATTER THAN

CVC (consonant, vowel, consonant) → lleva doble T

Adjectives that end in **Y** have an additional rule. **The letter Y turns into an I.**

For example:

FUNNY + ER + THAN → FUNN_____
