Vaccination is one of the greatest inventions that has impacted human health is vaccination. It has saved millions of lives worldwide and has caused many diseases to disappear. Vaccines immunize people by mobilizing antibodies (defenses) that fight the disease so that defenses learn to fight if the body is exposed to illnesses in the future. This first happened in 1796 when Edward Jenner prevented a child from getting smallpox. A century before, the Chinese had tried to use an infected skin tear to immunize against it. The vaccine for smallpox was first developed in 1798 and by 1979 it was globally eradicated. Before vaccines, smallpox had killed millions of people. Most vaccines we still use today were created in the early XX century and eliminated several terrible illnesses. Vaccines are older than antibiotics or anesthesia.
