

## CONDITIONALS WORKSHEET (ZERO-FIRST)

1. Answer orally the following questions, using zero conditional.

**ZERO CONDITIONAL** – use = it's a fact.

If + present + present

Examples: If you eat too much, you get fat.  
("you" means everyone)

Answer the following questions using the zero conditional:  
First look at this example. (You can start with the if clause or not.)

*What happens if you sit in the sun too long?*

*If you sit in the sun too long, you get burned.*

*You get burned if you sit in the sun too long.*

Examples: If you eat too much, you'll get fat.

("you" means the person I'm speaking to)
