

**Trees** have a thick hard stem called a trunk. They can be deciduous or evergreen.

**Bushes** have a thick hard stem with low branches.

**Grasses** are thin and flexible and usually short.

Plants make their own food through a process called **photosynthesis**. Plants use **CO<sub>2</sub>** (from the air), **sunlight** and **water and minerals** (from the soil) to produce **glucose** (food) and **oxygen**.
