QUESTION TAGS – USES

-A short question at the end of a statement

You are a teacher, aren't you?

-Yes/no question for agreement or confirmation

Name Personal pronoun
Peter isn't a teacher, is he?

QUESTION TAGS – TYPES

-Auxiliary

You have studied, isn't you?

-Modal verb

You must be healthy, mustn't you?

-Form of the verb to be

He is happy, isn't he?

QUESTION TAGS – INTONATION

-Rising

No se sabe la respuesta

-Falling

Si se sabe la respuesta (por confirmar)

QUESTION TAGS – EXCEPTIONS*

-I am late,	→	aren't I?
-I am early,	→	aren't I?
-Nobody went to the shop,	→	did they?
-Nothing is made,	→	is it?
-Don't speak, (imperatives)	→	will you?
-This is a pen, isn't it?	→	isn't it?
-There aren't mirrors,	→	are there?
-Let's go to the supermarket,	→	Shall we?
