Letter	Genre	Description
	Fairy Tale	A A story in which the reader or character must use clues, to solve a problem
	Drama	B stories that are so fantastic that they can't possibly be true. They often have strange and unworldly settings
	Folklore	C humorous stories with huge exaggerations & heroes
	Historical Fiction	D stories used to orally pass down through generations the beliefs and customs of a community. The original author is often 'unknown'
	Realistic Fiction	E stories where animals, plants or objects are behaving like humans. The purpose is to teach a life lesson known as the moral
	Tall Tale	F stories with made-up characters and events from the past
	Mystery	G stories written as a dialogue between characters to be performed in a theatre
	Fantasy	H stories about technology, life and settings in the future or on other planets
	Mythology	I stories that can happen in real life but didn't happen
	Science Fiction	J stories about ancient culture and often include supernatural elements
	Fable	K stories about magical creatures with happy endings usually written for children
