HONEST, HONOURABLE AND NO LONGER HOMELESS

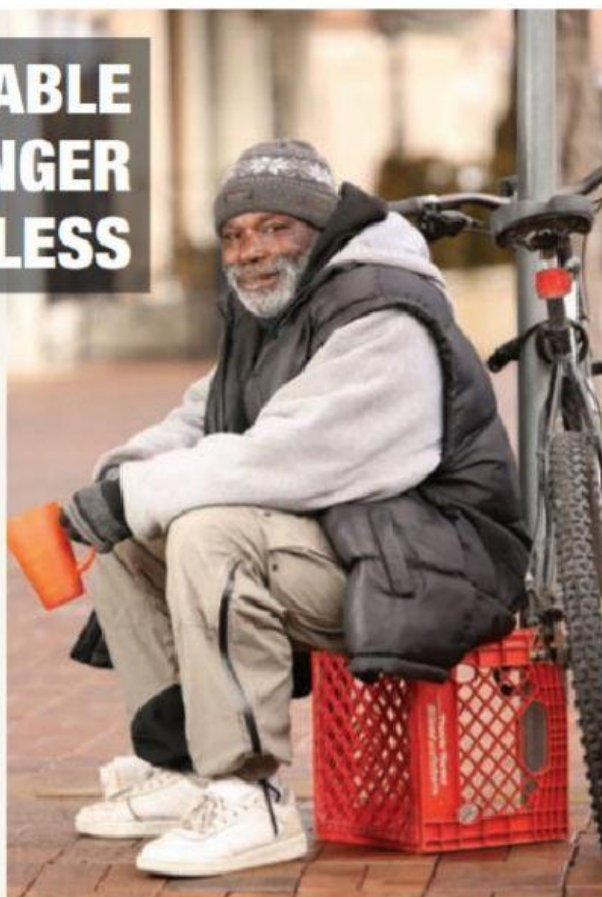
