YESTERDAY (= the day before today)	LAST	AGO
We can combine "yesterday" with a specific part of the day: yesterday morning yesterday afternoon yesterday evening	We can combine "last" with many words: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- last night- last week / last weekend- last + a specific day of the week: last Tuesday, last Sunday, last Monday, etc.- last month- last + a specific month: last August, etc.- last year- last + a season: last summer, last winter, last autumn, last spring- last Christmas	We use "ago" to say that something happened a number of minutes, days, years, etc. in the past. We combine "ago" with a period of time. Pay attention to the order of the words: A period of time + ago a minute ago two hours ago three days ago two weeks ago four months ago five years ago a long time ago
