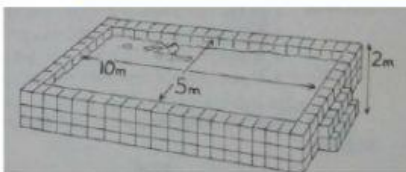

22 Writing: Opinion Essays

Analyse this example of an opinion essay

Paragraph 1- introduction

1 It is sometimes claimed that opposites attract when it comes to friendship. 2 On the whole, I don't agree with that opinion. I think that people pick friends with the same interests as them. That extends to physical appearance - if you have similar tastes, 3 you're likely to appreciate similar clothes and hairstyles. 4 5

It is sometimes claimed that 'opposites attract' when it comes to friendship. Write an essay in which you give your own opinion of this view taking into consideration personality and appearance.

Paragraph 1- introduction

1. It is not uncommon to start with the proposed title of the essay
2. Establish your general opinion on the topic (this can go here or at the end of the paragraph as an affirmative sentence or more interestingly posing a question)
- 3 and 4. Introduce two items on which you are going to base your opinion on, in this case, attraction based on looks and interests.
- Finally, 5 and this is optional. You can either ask the question, or put forward a general summary of your opinion (more extended than the general view in number 2)

Paragraph 2- 1st opinion

1 Personally, I think that you are more likely to be long-term friends with someone who is on the same wavelength as you. I think opposites do attract, but I don't think it lasts as those different qualities that attracted you at first can annoy you later! 2
My closest friend, Helen, is quite similar to me. Having said that, we do not have everything in common – in fact, the differences keep our friendship interesting. 3 However, our broad interests and personalities do resemble each other's and so it is easy to spend a lot of time together. 4 It's in the details that we differ. For example, we both love sport, but we don't support the same teams. And although we're both sociable, Helen is more outgoing than me. 5

1. Write a long sentence to set your opinion on the matter. (here you can give examples and that would be 2)
2. Here she admits that having differences sometimes is good and it's essential to provide an example and this would be number 3.
4. Go again to your general opinion and give an example in number 5 to support your idea

The use of "Personally", "Having said that", "However", "for example" and other synonyms is important to show coherence

Paragraph 3- 2nd point

1 When it comes to appearance, a similar appearance can lead to attraction. 2 Helen and I both have similar taste in clothes. We enjoy shopping together and swapping clothes. 3 If we had different interests, we wouldn't be able to enjoy these activities together. 4

1. Introduce your second view
2. and 3. Put your view forward with an example
3. make a statement as a conclusion on this point

Paragraph 4- conclusion

1 So, in my view, although you may be attracted to a friend who is completely opposite to you, the best kind of friend is one that you have enough in common with, so that your friendship lasts a long time. 2 3

1. Introduce your conclusion phrase
2. Establish a contrast between what you think and what is argued
3. make a final statement as a conclusion
