Nouns ending in

-ch, -sh, -s, -x, -z

add **-es**

box-boxes

watch - watches

Nouns ending in
consonant + y = **-ies**

country - countries

Nouns ending in **-f / -fe**

change to **-ves**

wife - wives

leaf leaves



Certain nouns that end
in **-o**, add **-es**

hero - heroes

potato - potatoes

But:

photo - photos; piano - pianos

hippo - hippos

Irregular plurals:

a child - children

a man - men

a woman - women

a person - people

a foot - feet

a tooth - teeth

a goose - geese

a mouse - mice

a sheep - sheep

a fish - fish

a deer - deer

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
