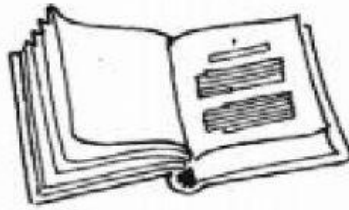
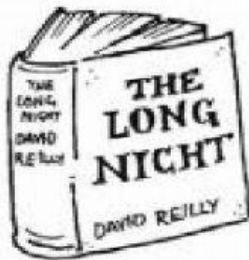

Hard Work

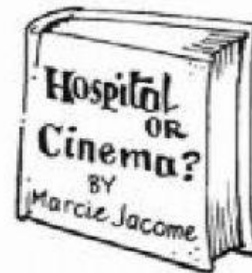
This exciting story is Joanna Jones's twentieth.
