### (Wh- Words)

1) Use \_\_\_\_\_ when you talk about a **PERSON**

e.g.: \_\_\_\_\_ is your teacher at school? Is it Mrs. Green?

2) Use \_\_\_\_\_ when you talk about **POSSESSION**

e.g.: \_\_\_\_\_ pencil is this? Is it your pencil? Is it Anna's pencil?

3) Use \_\_\_\_\_ when you ask about **TIME**

e.g.: \_\_\_\_\_ do you get up in the morning?

4) Use \_\_\_\_\_ when you ask about an **OBJECT / IDEA / ACTION**

e.g.: \_\_\_\_\_ is your favourite thing to do when you finish homework?

5) Use \_\_\_\_\_ when you want an **EXPLANATION**

e.g.: \_\_\_\_\_ is there water on the floor? Did you drop your bottle?

6) Use \_\_\_\_\_ when you ask about a **PLACE**

e.g.: \_\_\_\_\_ do you usually go on Sunday afternoon?

7) Use \_\_\_\_\_ when you ask about **A CHOICE**

e.g.: \_\_\_\_\_ do you like best? Cats or dogs?

8) Use \_\_\_\_\_ when you ask about the **MANNER**

e.g.: \_\_\_\_\_ do you get to school in the morning? Do you take the bus?
