

QUESTIONS : INTONATIONS & REPONSES COURTES

A) INTONATION dans les Questions : Dépend du type de question

Questions Ouvertes en **WH-** : l'intonation est **descendante** (= **falling** intonation)

Ex : Where do you live ? ↘ ; Who will embody the lead/main character ? ↘ ; How long is it going to last? ↘

Yes/No Questions = Questions fermées : L'intonation est **montante** (**Rising** intonation)

Ex : Was his movie successful? ↗ ; Is he going to be against us? ↗ ; Does his name stand out on the poster? ↗
