 - c. A male friend or relative that helps the groom on his wedding day.

 - e. The man getting married.
- 5. flower girl
 - f. A long piece of transparent fabric at the back of the bride's dress that trails along the ground
- 6. groom
 - g. The people who attend the wedding.
- 7. guests
 - h. A woman, usually a close friend or relative of the bride, who accompanies the bride and helps her on her wedding day.
- 8. maid of honor
 - i. Wedding tradition. The person who catches the bouquet is said to be the next person to get married.
- 9. ring bearer
 - j. The bride and groom speak about their feelings for each other.
- 10. throw the bouquet
 - k. A little girl who carries flowers at the start of the ceremony.
- 11. toast
 - l. to wish a person future health, happiness, and success and ask others to raise their glasses and join in a drink.
