How to Make a Paper Mask

Materials :

- Thick paper
- Two rubber bands
- A cutter
- Scissors
- Coloring pencils
- A pencil

Steps :

- First, draw pattern of a face as you like on the thick paper.
- Second, color or decorate your drawing.
- Third, use the scissors to cut out the picture. Follow the line.
- Then, use the cutter to make the holes for eyes and to make a small hole for each ear.
- Next, tie the rubber band on each hole.
- Finally try your mask on by hooking the rubber bands on your ears.

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Jakarta Coconut Rice

Ingredients :

2 cups of rice
3 cups of coconut milk
1 Indian bay leaf
3 lemon grass leaves
 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon of salt

Steps :

1. Put all the ingredients into a saucepan, and bring to a boil.
2. Turn off the heat, cover the pan and let the mixture stand for 15 minutes to allow the rice to absorb the coconut milk.
3. Place the rice on an aluminum foil square in the Chinese steamer.
4. Steam for 20 minutes to complete the cooking.
