- 1 Adjectives are often used *before / after* nouns. Adjectives are also often used *before / after* the verbs *be, look, become, seem, get, taste*, etc. to describe the subject of the verb.
- 2 Most adverbs are formed by adding _____ to the adjective, but some have the same form as the adjective: *fast, hard* and *later*. Adverbs can be used to modify verbs, _____, other adverbs and whole clauses or sentences.
