Reading a Recipe (Reading)

Reading: Read the text and answer the questions.

Chocolate Muffins

Ingredients

- 250g (1 2/3 cup) plain flour
- 50g (1/2 cup) cocoa powder
- 2 tsp baking powder
- 2 large egg
- 120g (1 1/4 cup) caster sugar
- 4 tbsp vegetable oil
- 200ml whole milk
- 100g chocolate chips (optional)



Method

STEP 1

Heat the oven to 180°C/160°C. Line a muffin tin with twelve muffin cases. Sieve the flour, cocoa and baking powder into a medium bowl. Mix together the egg, sugar, oil and milk together in a bowl, then gradually pour into the dry ingredients (add chocolate chips now to make double chocolate muffins, if you like) and mix until combined.

STEP 2

Spoon the mixture evenly into the cake cases and bake for 20-25 mins until a stick inserted into the middle comes out clean. Remove from the oven and leave to cool.
