Giving reasons: because/ in case/ so

- _____ means 'because something might happen'
- _____ gives the result of an action or state, whereas _____ gives the reason for an action or state.

Adding similar detail: and/ as well as/ too/ also

- We use _____ either in a separate sentence or joined with *and* or *as well as*
- We use *as well (as)* at the beginning of a sentence or in the middle of a sentence.
- We use _____ in the middle of a sentence.
- We use *too* at the end of the sentence, joined with *and* or *as well as*.
