P.RAMLEE



Tan Sri Datu Amar Dr. P. Ramlee was a legendary Malaysia film actor, director, singer, songwriter, composer and producer. Due to his contribution to the movie and the music industry as well as his literary work, he is often considered the Malaysian icon in entertainment.

P.Ramlee was born as Teuku Zakaria bin Teuku Nyak Puteh. His father, Teuku Nyak Puteh, was a sailor from Aceh, and later married Che Mah Hussain. He was born on 22nd March 1929. He started his career in 1947 when he won a singing competition organized by the Penang Radio. In 1957, he acted in his first comedy film, Bujang Lapok, along with Aziz Sattar and S. Shamsudin, which is still popular among the modern Malay film watchers.

On 27th May 1973, P.Ramlee died at the age of 44 due to a heart attack and was buried in Kuala Lumpur. In 1986, the P.Ramlee Memorial was built in honour of his contributions to the Malaysian entertainment industry. In 1990, he was awarded the "Tan Sri" title and later in 2009, the title "Datuk Amar" by Sarawak State Government.
