## Affirmative

S i n g u l a r	1 <sup>st</sup>	I sing
	2 <sup>nd</sup>	You sing
	3 <sup>rd</sup>	He sings She sings It sings
P l u r a l	1 <sup>st</sup>	We sing
	2 <sup>nd</sup>	You sing
	3 <sup>rd</sup>	They sing

Personal Pronoun + verb

**Third person singular**

<b>-s</b> Most verbs e.g. I talk → he talks I drive → she drives	<b>-es</b> Verbs ending in <b>-ss, -x, -sh, -ch, -o</b> e.g. I fix → she fixes I do → it does	<b>-ies</b> Verbs ending in Consonant + <b>y</b> e.g. I tidy → he tidies but I play → he plays

## Negative

S i n g u l a r	1 <sup>st</sup>	I don't sing
	2 <sup>nd</sup>	You don't sing
	3 <sup>rd</sup>	He doesn't sing She doesn't sing It doesn't sing
P l u r a l	1 <sup>st</sup>	We don't sing
	2 <sup>nd</sup>	You don't sing
	3 <sup>rd</sup>	They don't sing

Personal Pronoun + don't + verb

Third person singular:  
Personal Pronoun + doesn't + verb

## Interrogative

S i n g u l a r	1 <sup>st</sup>	Do I sing?
	2 <sup>nd</sup>	Do you sing?
	3 <sup>rd</sup>	Does he sing? Does she sing? Does it sing?
P l u r a l	1 <sup>st</sup>	Do we sing?
	2 <sup>nd</sup>	Do you sing?
	3 <sup>rd</sup>	Do they sing?

Do + Personal Pronoun + verb... ?
