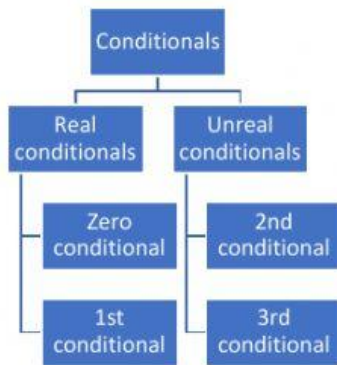


CONDITIONALS

We use conditionals to talk about situations and their consequences.



STRUCTURE OF A CONDITIONAL

If condition ,	result.
Result (no comma)	if condition.

Zero conditional

Facts (hechos)

If/When	condition ,	result																
If/When	present simple,	present simple																
If/When	water cools below zero degrees,	it freezes.																
If/When	the moon gets in the way of the sun's light,	there is a solar eclipse.																
If/When	the service in a restaurant is good,	do you leave a tip?

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1st conditional

Possibilities in the present or future.

If	condition ,	result
If	present simple,	future (will)
If	the kid eats a lot of chocolate,	he will get ill.
If	my friend calls me,	I will go with her to a party.
If	it is warm today,	will we go the park?
	I /you / we/ they	he/she/it
	+) 😊 subject + verb s.f. + rest. I work every day.	+) 😊 subject + verb -s + rest. She works every day.
	DO	DOES
	-) 😞 subject + do not + verb. s.f. + rest. I don't work every day.	-) 😞 subject + does not + verb s.f. + rest. She doesn't work every day.
		+) I will work. -) I won't work. Will I work? will not = won't
